After a dry April weather turned more seasonable in May with plenty of May showers and cooler weather. The grapes started flowering a little earlier than normal and we have had cool, showery weather which usually means we will have a lighter fruit set. Grape vines are self pollinating and the amount of fruit we get is dependent on heat and light. This year we are experiencing "June Gloom" which is typical but not in the last fiver years.

Typically harvest starts 90days after flowering or "bloom" as we refer to it. We don't anticipate a big fruit set this year becuse of the cooler, cloudy weather but time will tell.
