2009 LeNez Pinot Noir	\$30.00	\$27.00	\$24.00
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The 2009 vintage in the Northern Willamette Valley was characterized by a plentiful fruit set with larger than normal clusters and a warm summer. The resulting wines are forward, higher in alcohol than usual and delicious for short term drinking. The 2009 LeNez Pinot Noir represents all the clones in the vineyard. The wine is full of the mocha, blackberry aromatics I typically associate with Lenné. The wine has good mid-palate concentration and a long, generous finish. I would highly recommend drinking this wine over the next 3-5 years. While generous now, it will gain aromatic complexity with some short term bottle age.

2009 Lenné Estate Pinot Noir	\$45.00	\$40.50	\$36.00
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While most winemakers and critics are doing back flips over the 2008 vintage, I have always suspected that the majority of consumers will like the 2009 vintage better. This was born out over the Thanksgiving weekend when the 2009 vintage outsold the 2008 Lenné Pinot Noirs. No surprise really. The wines are soft, lush and have beautiful aromatics. While drinkable now, they will gather complexity with short term cellaring. The 2009 Lenné Estate has concentrated blackberry, raspberry and chocolate aromas. The wine is rich and supple with a long finish. I encourage you to open and try these 2009 wines. They will be great over the next 3-5 years.

2009 Lenné Coq D' OR Pinot Noir	\$20.00	\$18.00	\$16.00
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In 2009 I had a decision to make: reserve the best barrels for Lenné Estate and put everything else in the LeNez bottling or come up with a third solution. My dilemma was that the 2009 vintage produced rich wines, but not all of which had the concentration typical of our wines My original intention with the LeNez Pinot Noir was to create the best Pinot Noir in it's price range. In order to keep that promise, I decided to separate a third of our production into a lower price point Pinot Noir called Coq D' Or. This delicious wine will shine over the next 2-3 years. It doesn't have the concentration of our other two wines, but offers delicious, forward bing and black cherry fruit and moderate concentration. Like all the 2009 wines, it should be delicious with the cool weather coming. **I have also reduced the price to \$20.00, that is \$16.00 by the case.**

Note: The 2009 vintage is drinking well now and I wouldn't lay them down for more than 3 years. .
