## Whats new in the Vineyard



After the driest spring on record the vines started to show the first signs of flowering right before Memorial Day. After some brief heat, early June gave us cool, showery weather which can result in a lighter fruit set. Grape vines are self pollinating and the amount of fruit we get is dependent on heat and light. This year we are experiencing “June Gloom” which is typical.

Typically harvest starts 90days after flowering or “bloom” as we refer to it so it looks like a harvest in mid-September this year but time will tell.
