## Whats new in the Vineyard



March is a busy time of year in the vineyard. We are finished pruning and tying the vines. Tying is when we take the one fruiting cane that is left after pruning and bend it and tie it to the fruiting wire. Each new cane will emerger from this primary cane. The prunnings left on the ground are usually ground up and decompose in the vineyard. This year we tried something new and our vineyard foreman Mark, built a brush rake and we pulled the cuttings out and burned them.

The advantage of burning the cuttings is that they harbor mites which can cause issues with photosynthesis when the population gets out of control We have had more mites in the last three years and this should help keep the population under control
