## Whats new in the Vineyard



People always get nervous in farming so I understood when I heard rublings because of the cool spring time weather. I kept hearing that bud break was late but in reality we just got used to three consecutive vintages with early starts.

We are about on track with where we were in 2008 and 2012. Those vintages turned out okay. If you recall in 2011, the coldest vintage ever, we were just starting to see budbreak at the end of May. This year we have over 24" of growth on the canes. I would anticipate that we will see a very normal harvest date somewhere around the beginning of October which is normal.

What will the vintage bring? Ask us about the third week of September and we will give you a good answer.
