Whats new in the Vineyard



March is a busy time of year in the vineyard. We are finished pruning and tying the vines. Tying is when we take the one fruiting cane that is left after pruning and bend it and tie it to the fruiting wire. Each new cane will emerger from this primary cane. March is also a time to get all of our equipment ready for a new year.

This March has turned wet with below average temperatures. Last year we had one of our earliest but breaks ever seeing signs by the 19th of March in 2015. We anticipate it to be later this year. The forecast is for another early warm summer due to El Nino. Only time will tell but I think we will see bud break around the end of the month. We are hoping for some dry weather so we can get into the vineyard and spray prior to bud break. Oh the life of a farmer, always worrying about things you can't control.
