2019 Lenné Estate Pinot Noir

The 2019 Lenné Estate Pinot Noir is entirely estate fruit and the pommard clone makes up nearly half of the blend. The wine has mixed red and black fruit aromatics and mocha notes. On the palate the wine is perfectly balanced with mouthwatering acidity and fine grained tannins framing a long finish. Drinkable now but will evolve over the next decade. Decant if drinking now.

2018 Sad Jack 777 Pinot Noir

This wine has dark black and red fruits. On the palate the wine is layered and has plenty of fine grained tannins and mouth-watering acidity framing a long finish. This is a great cellar candidate and will reward those of you who have patience with a delicious, rich and complex wine. Will evolve over the next decade, easily.

2019 Lenné Estate Jill's 115 Pinot Noir

The 115 clone has become one of our favorites over the years. This clone gives us fine grained tannins resulting in the silkiest mouthfeel over time. The wine is more red fruited than black with the underlying mocha aromatic. Angular now but will evolve into a beauty over the next ten to twelve years.

2017 LeNez Pinot Noir







This wine is a tremendous value for the quality in the bottle. Bright bing and black cherry fruit with mocha aromatics. The 2017 LeNez is starting to soften and is very drinkable now but will continue to evolve over the next decade.

2019 LeNez Pinot Noir

We love the 2019 vintage and it reminds us of the 2016 vintage. The moderate growing season produced perfectly balanced wines with bright red and black cherry fruits and mocha aromatics. While the 2019 wines can be consumed now, even a year of cellaring will make a world of difference. We expect the wines to improve over the next decade.

2016 Lenné Estate Pinot Noir

Like all of our wines, the 2016 Lenné Estate Pinot Noir is entirely estate fruit with the pommard clone makes up nearly half of the blend. The wine has mixed red and black fruit aromatics with violets, mocha and a faint sandalwood aromatic that happens with all Lenné Pinots with bottle age. Last chance at this wine.
