## Whats new in the Vineyard



We are nearly a month behind this year because of our cool spring. Normally we see flowering in June and cool showery weather which can result in a lighter fruit set. Grape vines are self pollinating and the amount of fruit we get is dependent on heat and light. This year we are experiencing “June Gloom” which is typical but we suspect we won’t see much flowering until the end of the month and into July this year.

Typically harvest starts 90days after flowering or “bloom” as we refer to it so we will see but we all suspect a very late harvest this year.
