Whats new in the Vineyard



March is a busy time of year in the vineyard. We are finished pruning and tying the vines. Tying is when we take the one fruiting cane that is left after pruning and bend it and tie it to the fruiting wire. Each new cane will emerger from this primary cane. March is also a time to get all of our equipment ready for a new year.

This March is very typical of vintages past and we anticipate bud break about the same as last year but only time will tell. We don't mind a wet winter and spring as it provides a good water source if we get a dry, hot summer. But we need enought dry weather to be able to get into the vineyard and spray early. People always ask what will the vintage be like but we never know until the end though we always prefer an early start to the vintage.
