## Whats new in the Vineyard



After another warm summer we start preparing for another harvest. The vineyard work is done for the year with one exception. We will start spreading seed between every other row. The seed is a mix of rye, lugumes and clover which helps fix nitrogen in the vineyard the following spring. It also helps to collect winter rain and prevent excessive runoff.

Preparing for harvest means getting grape bins washed and ready as well as all of the other equipment in the winery. Harvest at Lenné is all done by hand and usually involves three or four picks spread out over 10 days.
